What's new? We've come such a long way towards emerging from this pandemic year. Getting all the way there requires that we keep safety right next to fun on our list of top priorities. We're determined to use our building and our outdoor spaces creatively to provide a joyful and safe summer!

- Current safety precautions will remain in place including mask wearing by campers/ teachers/staff, social distancing, handwashing, daily temperature checks.
- Some classes, specifically Ceramics and Theatre, will be held outdoors whenever possible
- Indoor classrooms will have open windows as well as air purifiers
- Each group of campers will have a designated inside classroom and bathroom



- Each camper will have a personal set of art supplies to be used through their camp session

PAINTING, DRAWING & PRINTMAKING

Students gain skills in various painting media, drawing techniques, and printing processes including embossing, stamping, mono-prints and collagraphs.

CERAMICS, SCULPTURE, COLLAGE & ASSEMBLAGE

Students use found objects, traditional art materials, paper maché and paint to create 3-Dimensional pieces. Students explore clay through pinch, coil and slab building to make anything from functional pottery to hand built sculpture.

- Our enthusiastic, college age counselors will stay with your child's age group throughout their camp session
- Campers, as always, bring their own lunch and water bottle.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required per child per session to secure all registrations and will be credited towards the total amount due.
- Full payment must be received by June 11 for Crafty Kids 1 and Sessions 1&2; by July 19 for Sessions 3&4 and Crafty Kids 2. No camper may attend if full fees are not paid.
- Members receive a discount on tuition.
- Sibling discount: Each additional student receives a \$25 discount per camp session (\$10 for Crafty Kids).
- Register by May 1st and receive 5% off total tuition. Full payment required by 11:59pm 5/1/21.
- **Picture Policy:** Upon registration families give permission to the Center to publish student photographs in print or on the web for fundraising and press purposes.

Our age groups are limited in size to provide a quality program. Camp fees include all supplies, programming fees and T-shirt. Fees incurred to CCA from returned checks (NSF) are the responsibility of the parent/guardian. We regret that we cannot provide refunds for time missed due to a change in plans, family vacation or a child's illness. Cheltenham Center for the Arts does not prorate for camp. Cheltenham Center for the Arts staff. faculty and counselors do not disburse or handle prescription or over-thecounter medication and are not trained to care for special needs children. Parent/Guardians are required to complete our Camp Medical form and discuss any physical/behavioral concerns prior to the start of camp.
